

ORDINANCE NO. 21

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DISCHARGE OF FIREWORKS
WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF HILLCREST VILLAGE, TEXAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HILLCREST
VILLAGE, TEXAS:

SECTION I:

It shall be unlawful for any person to cast, throw, or fire any rocket, cracker, torpedo, grenade, cap, cartridge or other combustible fireworks of any kind within the city limits of Hillcrest Village.

SECTION II:

a. No person shall permit the explosion of fireworks upon property owned or occupied by that person within the city limits.

b. No person, guardian, or person in loco parentis shall permit his or her child or ward to discharge or explode fireworks within the city limits.

SECTION III:

Any person violating this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined in any sum not less than \$10.00 and not more than \$200.00, and each and every day or fraction of a day during which this ordinance shall be violated, shall be deemed as a separate offense and punishable as such.

Any fireworks found on any person is subject to confiscation by the City Marshal.

SECTION IV:

Whereas an emergency is apparent for the immediate preservation of order, health, safety and the general welfare of the public and requires this ordinance to become effective immediately; therefore, it shall be effective from and after the date of its passage.
