

ORDINANCE NO. 5 B

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HILLCREST VILLAGE, TEXAS,
AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 5 TO REQUIRE THE VACCINATION OF
ALL ANIMALS FOUND WITHIN THE CITY

Whereas, Ordinance No. 5, executed March 8, 1971 provides for the vaccination of dogs and due to the recurrent rabies problem, the City Council has determined it to be in the public interest to extend the scope of said ordinance to all animals; therefore, be it

ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HILLCREST
VILLAGE, TEXAS:

THAT Ordinance No. 5, Section 4 be and it is hereby amended and superceded as follows:

SECTION 4:

That it shall be unlawful for any person within the limits of said Town to own, keep, possess, harbor, or allow to remain upon premises under his control any animal over the age of six (6) months which does not have a current vaccination and license as prescribed by the laws of the State of Texas, if applicable, and any animal not confined shall wear its vaccination license.

This amendment to Ordinance No. 5 shall become effective upon its passage and after its publication as required by law.

PASSED on the first reading on July 13, 1982.

PASSED on the second reading on the 11th day of August, 1982.

PASSED on the third reading on the 8th day of September, 1982.
